

It is important that EVERY property owner votes, so that we can modernize these outdated rules and restrictions. In doing so, this will give the community covenants that are easier to understand and follow, and ultimately will guide us for many years to come.

neighborhood watch news

Can you believe it's already BACK TO SCHOOL time?

A major safety concern for your Neighborhood Watch and Security Committee teams are speeding in the community, and distracted driving. Unfortunately, we've had plenty of both over the summer!

We are asking all parents to remind your kids of the basics of road safety, and that they need to be alert when getting on and off the school bus, or in and out of carpool areas.

Drivers, PLEASE SLOW DOWN and put down the phone! The 2.5 seconds you save by speeding in our community is NOT WORTH hurting a child. Neither is immediately responding to that text message. Penalties for passing stopped school bus include:

- Moving violation subject to citation.
- Requirement to complete a basic Driver Improvement Course upon conviction.
- Four points on your driver license;

and

• Minimum fine of \$165, if you pass on the side where children enter and exit, you will receive a minimum fine of \$265.

REAL ESTATE

We are in crazy, uncertain times with rapidly changing information.

Although the news isn't always ideal, it's not as ominous as some might make you believe.

Let's start with the hard facts:

- Inflation is [presently] reported at 8.6 %, which is a 40-year high.
- The feds just raised the federal funds rate by 75 basis points.
- While interest rates and inflation rise, affordability is dropping quickly. Buyers who were preapproved months ago no longer have the same purchasing power.
- Residential lending is currently down 32%, leading to layoffs in the mortgage industry.
- Although Florida has four of the top ten cities for real estate investors, there is a definite pull back occurring.
- Zillow and Redfin are also experiencing staffing cutbacks.

Even with these unanticipated changes, I don't believe the news is all grim. There are some things happening that point to a market stabilization, which was greatly needed. We knew this was eventually going to come along but it doesn't mean the sky is falling. According to U.S. News and World Report, Tampa, FL was recently ranked among the top 50 best places to live. In the first two months of 2022, more than 9,000 people moved to the area.

The economic slow down is expected to increase home inventory and slow the hysteria that has been the norm for the past couple of years. Although buyers have less buying power than they did just months ago, there will now be more homes to choose from and buyers should soon have more leverage.

According to Florida Realtors®, although the pace has slowed, people are still spending at a healthy pace. That's a measurable sign of how the economy is performing.

Just by the looks of our local May 2022 MLS statistics, the signs of a shift have begun. Active Listings are up 28% from the month prior and up 9% from a year ago, New Listings are also up, and Pending Sales are starting to show a small but detectable downshift. This means actively listed homes are beginning to sit longer, which could indicate that we are exiting the "extreme" sellers market we have been in for the past two years. On the other hand, Sales Volume & Average Sales Prices are both trending upward. According to Stellar MLS, as of May 2022, the Average Sales Price in our local market was \$452,922, up 2% from April 2022 and up 21% from May 2021. This signals that while homes will have longer Days On Market, the home values from the past two years have already set in. Consumers may begin to notice an increase in price improvements as sellers attempt to catch up to the ever-changing market conditions.

It's as important now as it ever was to work with a knowledgeable professional for your home buying and selling needs. The market is an agile environment right now and can even feel somewhat uncertain. It's much better to be prepared and well-informed when heading into any type of real estate transaction, which for most consumers, is by far their largest asset.


