Proposed Calendar

Each entry would pay \$1 and this money would go into a pot. Guests would be able to vote for their favorite car and the winner gets the pot as well as a simple trophy. Hotdogs and water would be available for purchase for a minimal fee. We would like to use the Beach Club hotdog warmer. Kids would also be able to have a contest for the best decorated bike, scooter, or wagon.
- 4. Turkey Trot on Thanksgiving morning. We would like to host the first annual Cory Lake Wacky Wobble- a costume clad 5k around the loop. The prize would be a ridiculous feathered turkey crown- one for adults and one for kids. Kids could decorate their bikes, scooters, wagons, and strollers. This is an untimed event. We would charge a minimal rsvp fee and look for a water and snack sponsor.
- 5. NYE party at beach club- we would have to separate events. The first one would be for kids (hopefully we can get a magician) and then follow the show with a Netflix ball drop around 8pm. For the adults we would have a formal casino night (if we can still book) and then cocktails, appetizers, champagne toast, and dancing. The party would end after midnight.

6. Need to request funds for the bails of hay for the scarecrow stuffing as well as bottled water- approx. \$50-\$75. We will charge \$2 per child.
